

SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2010-2011

It was dream to start a NGO with the name NOBODAY for years but it became true in the year 2010. It was not a sudden event. Planning to serve people and working on it was started well before the Society formed and got its registration. For last one year it was a continuous endeavor to get touch with the village people as our main objective is Rural Development.

Finding out a village named **UPAR SAKARMA** was not also an accident. For last two years we were looking for a village where the basic need of the human being is not reached till to this date. Discussion with various people helped us to find out the village and was visited by us in the year 2009 but it was not possible for us to start work with the people of that village in that year.

In the year 2010 Mr.Sujit Sarkar joined there as a Primary School Teacher in that village and started discussion the conditions of the villagers. With his active interest we started working with them; latter formed our Society to serve the people in an organized way.

I personally feel the basic need of the people is EMPLOYMENT, not food, not Cloth and not the roof on their head. If a man started earning then he automatically will go for his food, cloth and shelter. So I gave my full effort on the employment generation of the people.

*To make my mission successful we met the District Manager, West Bengal Scheduled Caste - Scheduled Tribe Development and Financial Corporation, Malda, Mr. Bikash Saha, WBCS. On his active guidance we formed three Self Help Groups namely, **Upar Sakarma NABADOY SHG-1** (with 15 ST women), **Upar Sakarma NABADOY SHG-2** (with 15 SC women) & **Upar Sakarma NABADOY SHG-3** (with 15 ST women). Bank account for the there SHGs were opened in the month of December with active help of our society in Gangiya Gramin Vikash Bank, Sahapur Branch, Malda. After grooming them for six months they applied for financial assistance and subsidy to West Bengal Scheduled Caste - Scheduled Tribe Development and Financial Corporation, Malda. The prayers are forwarded for necessary approval and were under process*

Activities for last one year.

BLOOD DONATION CAMP : The first meeting of the Society was held in the month of August, 2011 and on that month we organized a Blood Donation Camp on 31/08/2010 with active participation & patronage of State Bank of India, Malda Branch. The then District Magistrate, Sri Pramal Kumar Samanta inaugurated the camp. Total 71 (seventy one) donors donated blood.

WORK ON RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI 2005) : After completion of training of RTI provided by the Service Group, a Kolkata based organization the members of the society under the leadership of Sri Sujit Kumar Chaudhuri, Treasurer, PNWS, are working on RTI, 2005 and in many cases the members forced the Government authorities to give answers to the questions placed before them. Some of the cases are forwarded to the commission for natural justice.

FREE MEDICAL CAMP : The society organized Free Medical Camp on 05th day of December, 2010 at Upar Sakarma Primary School. Dr. G. N. Chaudhury, MBBS, attended the camp as attending physician. About 59 people were served with free Medical Examination, free ECG Test, free Blood Sugar Test and Free supply of Medicine.

DISTRIBUTION OF CLOTH : The society distributed cloth with the kind patronage of Dr. Kalyan Sanyal, MD, among the children of the village Upar Sakarma in the month of October, 2010. Our Assistant Secretary, Sri Sujit Sarkar took special initiative for it.

ADVOCASY, COMMUNICATION & SOCIAL MOBILIZATION (ACSM) : The Society took active part to educate the poor people for various economical, social and health and hygiene programme to uplift the living standard of the poor.

Constant propaganda against Tuberculosis, AIDS and Sanitation is going on. Movement against child marriage, child labour, consumers' rights and right to education is also being organized through various meeting and gathering.

STAND BY PEOPLE : The society took special initiative to treat a poor school boy, Swapan Roy of the village Upar Sakarma when he was suffering with abdominal problem with Dr. Manabesh Pramanik, MS. Now the boy is out of danger and leading his normal life.

A tribal man, Ratan Hansda of the village Upar Sakarma was also served by the society when he was severely ill with high fever. He was transferred to at Malda Medical College & Hospital and after completion of treatment he returned to his home and living his normal life.



Training attended

As a representative of the society I attended the following training

1. **TRAINING ON RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI 2005)** : Participated two days residential training programme on RTI 2005 on 14/08/2010 & 15/08/2010 at Hotel Continental Lodge, Malda, organized by Service Group, a Kolkata based Organization.
2. **TRAINING ON CONSUMERS' PROTECTION ACT** : Participated two days training on Consumers' Protection Act on 02/12/2010 & 03/12/2010 at Continental Lodge, Malda organized by State Consumers' Protection Department.

OUR FUTURE PLAN

It is already mentioned that the society was formed with the dream to serve the poor rural people. We consider serving the poor villagers as our primary duty. To make our goal success, we have planned to develop a single village as an ideal village. The village UPAR SAKARMA, under the GP Sahapur of Old Malda Block, under Malda District has selected by all the members of the society and we are working hard to develop the village in all respect.

As a first step of development we are going to establish employment generation among the members of the SHGs. A land of Ten Katha (approx) of one Sri Binod Roy of the village is selected where the SHGs will open a Workshop cum Business Centre. In that centre Food Product Unit, Food Stock Unit, Live Stock Unit and other Vocational Training Unit will be opened with the financial assistance received from the West Bengal Scheduled Caste- Scheduled Tribe Development and Financial Corporation and the income generated from the business will be distributed among the members of the SHGs.

The Society is planning to open a Farmers' Club with technical and financial help of NABARD in the village to develop the agricultural scenario of the village. Various economic ventures will be made with the members of the club as per guide line of NABARD to develop the economy of the village.

The village needs proper sanitation. The society has a plan to set sanitary mud in every house of the village so that the villagers do not use the open field for toilet etc.

The society has a plan to keep a man pulled Van Ambulance in the village so that the ill villagers can avail the facility of the vehicle for all 24 hours to reach hospital.

The Society wants to ensure the education of all the children of the village and a special drive will be taken by the society for the mission.

Every activity needs monetary assistance. This year all the expenditure of the society is met with the subscription, donation and personal loan from various members. This situation is not a healthy situation for a society. To ensure the earning of the society, the members of the society are planning to open an English Medium School in the town or nearby the town and earning generated from the school will be spent for various philanthropic activities of the society.
